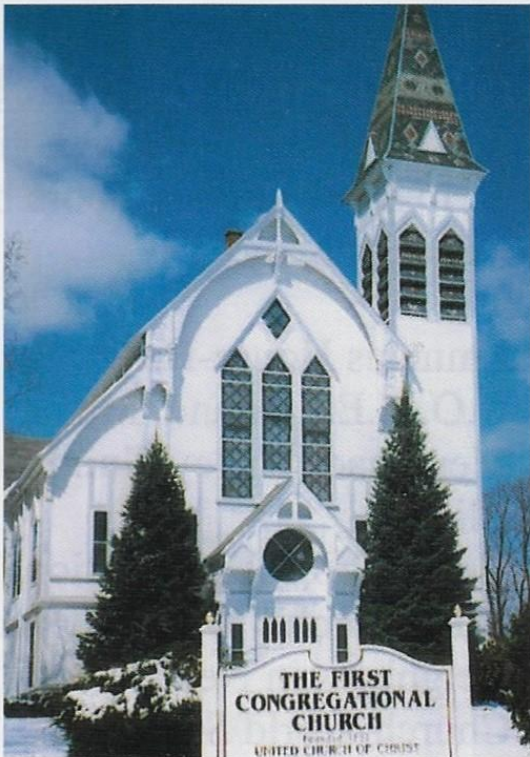

Our History and Facilities

Originally called the Second Congregational Church of Rowley, the First Congregational Church of Georgetown, U.C.C. is over 250 years old. After several relocations, our present church home was constructed in 1874. We are centrally located at 7 Andover Street, across from the Town Hall at the intersection of Route 97 and 133.

The unique architecture of our historic building is enhanced by our beautiful 1874 tracker-action organ and our Paul Revere and Sons Bell that calls us to worship every week. Our building is fully accessible with an elevator. Handicap/disabled parking is located in the lot off Cottage Street.

Worship

Worshipping God is at the center of our lives together.

- Sunday worship begins at 10:30 a.m.
- The Sacrament of Communion is celebrated on the first Sunday of each month.
- Adult supervised childcare is provided for infants and toddlers.
- Church School Classes run concurrently with the service.
- *Summer worship (mid-June through August) begins at 10:00 a.m.

We provide a variety of Christian Ed. options for individuals of all ages.

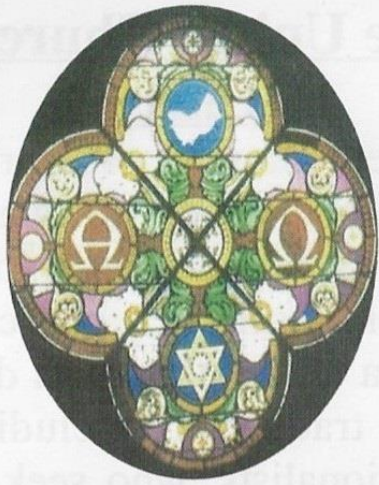
- We offer Church School Classes for ages 3 through 13.
