Our theme for Lent this year is, "Seeking: An invitation to Look Again"

Through these 40 days, I'm inviting you all to deeper curiosity of who Jesus is and what he did in his lifetime. If we are called to follow Jesus's examples and his teachings, then we need to learn more about his life.

I use the term "seeking" because it communicates a desire to find something; an awareness of a need for something that we don't yet have, to fill a void perhaps. And each of us does this differently. Many of us don't even know we are seeking, or that we have a void in that needs to be filled. Others share openly of our drive to find what we feel is missing. And many of us are somewhere in between. Wherever you find yourself as a friend or member of FCC, I invite you to a deeper awareness of what you might be seeking in church and in the life and lessons of Jesus.

In the book we are reading together during Lent, *Freeing Jesus* (click here for more about this book), the author, Diana Bass, opens us the world of different ways of understanding Jesus: Friend, Teacher, Savior, Lord, Way, and Presence. What names do you have for Jesus?

We recently took a closer look at how we may stay faithful in living into our new Vision Statement, as we believe we were called by God, as God's beloved to: *foster* our relationships, *connect* to the wider community and *commit* to responding in faith to the needs of the wider community. (Here is the complete Vision Statement)

We will wonder together about Nicodemus the Pharisee and Jewish scholar who comes seeking clarification from Jesus in the dark of night. (John 3:1-17) Then, we'll read about Jesus meeting the Samaritan woman at the well in the mid-day sun. (John 4:5-42) Jesus comes thirsty to the well, seeking water or so it seems. But who is seeking in this story? And what are they looking for?

On March 19th, Rich Brock will be preaching on the blind man healed of his sight teaching others to see him again in a whole new way. (John 9:1-41) And finally, we'll study the story of Lazarus who Jesus brings back to life – unbound of this life's limitations. (John 11:1-45)

So, what are you seeking? What are you looking for this Lenten season? And who has Jesus been to you in your lifetime?

Let's explore together, seeking to see Jesus again for the first time.
