### From The Hill

"My soul proclaims your greatness, O God, and my spirit rejoices in you, my Savior. For you have looked with favor upon your lowly servant, and from this day forward all generations will call me blessed. For you, the Almighty, have done great things for me, and holy is your Name. Your mercy reaches from age to age for those who fear you. You have shown strength with your arm; you have scattered the proud in their conceit; you have deposed the mighty from their thrones and raised the lowly to high places. You have filled the hungry with good things, while you have sent the rich away empty. You have come to the aid of Israel your servant, mindful of your mercy the promise you made to our ancestors to Sarah and Abraham and their descendants forever." (Luke 1:46-55)

Dear Church,

Is this reading/poem above familiar to you?

The Magnificat - this is Mary's (mother of Jesus) song rejoicing as she joyfully proclaims her role in the future of humanity, bringing to humankind God, in the flesh.

No slouch, this young Mary. And for sure no wall flower. For she sings:

and from this day forward, all generations shall call me blessed. . .

What is it about Mary, this mother of Jesus? What do you understand about Mary? Her life? Her childhood? Her role in the coming of Christianity? What about her role in the Church worldwide today? We, in the UCC, don't spend much time talking or thinking about Mary. But as the world continues to face ever-widening economic and political gaps and divides, and war seems to continue, I wonder if it's time we turned and looked deeper. Perhaps it is time to better understand this bearer of the Prince of Peace.

Biblical scholars don't all agree on her exact age or details of her life before she was tapped on the shoulder by that angle Gabriel. Remember, the story is that soon after she is confronted with this holy assignment, Mary set off to the hill country to find her much older cousin Elizabeth. And Elizabeth is also pregnant, miraculously. The pure Mary and the ancient Elizabeth both unlikely bearers of the next generation, and both biblical game changers for humanity. And as Mary approaches, Elizabeth's womb leaps with joy.

For who is Elizabeth carrying in her womb, but none other than Jesus's (distant) cousin, John – the Baptist! The one we meet in the opening lines of the Gospel of Mark who announces the coming of the Messiah. John and Jesus were a team from birth it seems.

Is this just a family business venture? Or is it something more?

We will spend some time this Advent season with Mary's Magnificat. Some say it is a song of revolutionary love. *What do you say?* 

I invite you to read this again, and take a moment –

- What visions come to you as you read this line by line?
- Where do you find hope, peace, joy and love in this poem?
- What else do you find here?

As we enter the season of Advent (which means "coming") may we each pause to seek out ways of bearing God's love and light into the dark spots of our world.

May we prepare the way for the Prince of Peace to reign in our hearts always, so that others who we meet can't help but to join us in ushering in a new world without war or hate or violence.

Bell choir and has begun rehearsals! All are welcome, though ability to read music is required. Join us Tuesdays at 6:30 PM.




### From the Member at Large...

Some of us get into trouble when we have too much time on our hands. . . *just sayin'* it's best to keep busy and stay out of trouble.








